1. LET _____ BEFORE _____.

“It was the first year of the reign of Darius the Mede who was made king of the Babylonians (by Cyrus). During the first year of his reign, I, Daniel, was studying the Scriptures. I learned from the Word of the Lord, as recorded by Jeremiah the prophet, that Jerusalem must lie desolate for seventy years” (Daniel 9:1-2).

“If you stay connected to me and my words remain in your heart, you may ask any request you want in prayer, and it will be given to you” (John 15:7).

“God says this to you: “You will be kept in Babylon for seventy years. But then I’ll keep my gracious promise to bring you back to your home again. 2. FOCUS MY _____ **ON GOD.**

“So I gave my attention to the Lord to seek Him by prayer” (Daniel 9:3a NASB).

“You will find me when you seek me with all your heart” (Jeremiah 29:13).

“Seek first God’s kingdom, before everything else, and all the other things you need will be given to you” (Luke 12:31 NCV).

“Your Kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven” (Matthew 6:10 ESV).
