What was the Starting Point for the First Christians?

(Acts 17:16-32)

1. DON'T SETTLE FOR AN UNKNOWN GOD.

“For as I walked around and looked carefully at your objects of worship, I even found an altar with this inscription: to an unknown god. So you are ignorant of the very thing you worship—and this is what I am going to proclaim to you,”

(Acts 17:23 NIV).

2. RECEIVE GOD'S INVITATION TO KNOW HIM.

“God did this so that they would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from any one of us,” (Acts 17:27 NIV).

3. ASK YOURSELF: WHO IS JESUS?

“For he has set a day when he will judge the world with justice by the man he has appointed. He has given proof of this to everyone by raising him from the dead,”

(Acts 17:31 NIV).
