



“The Centurion”

Face to Face with a Roman Officer

November 10-11, 2018

“When Jesus entered the village of Capernaum, a captain in the Roman army approached him, asking for a miracle” (*Matthew 8:5 TPT*).

1. Be faithful for a hundred or more.

“But the Roman officer interjected, “Lord, who am I to have you come into my house? *I understand your authority*, for I too am a man who walks under authority and have authority over soldiers who serve under me.” (*Matthew 8:8-9 TPT*).

2. To understand authority, walk under it with humility.

“Jesus was astonished when he heard this and said to those who were following him, “**He has greater faith than anyone I’ve encountered in Israel**” (*Matthew 8:10 TPT*)!

3. When you approach and ask for a miracle, You astonish Jesus.

Discussion Questions:

1. How has Holy Spirit spoken to you through this message?
2. Reflect on the people in your life. Are there people you can give a word or encouragement? Pray for? Support?
3. Humility can be thought of as thinking on the the needs of others before your own. How have you displayed this principle lately?
4. What is your understanding of boldness?
5. Why would you want to live a life that astonishes Jesus?
