Three ways to remain SAFE (Safely Away From the Enemy):

1. Don't take **DIRECTIONS** from this world

"How happy is the man who does not follow the advice of the wicked or take the path of sinners or join a group of mockers!" Psalm 1:1, HCSB

2. **FOLLOW** the **INSTRUCTIONS** of God's Word

"Instead, his delight is in the Lord's instruction, and he meditates on it day and night. He is like a tree planted beside streams of water that bears its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers." Psalm 1:2, HCSB

3. **FIND** friends who **LEAD** you to Jesus.

"Two are better than one because they have a good return for their labor. If either of them falls down, one can help the other up. But pity anyone who falls and has no one to help them up ... Though one may be overpowered, two can defend themselves' - Ecclesiastes 4:9-12, NIV

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION & DISCUSSION

1. Consider what is familiar that keeps you comfortable?
2. Does that "familiarity" tempt you away from or draw you closer to what God has for you?
3. Consider the temptations in your life, when you are in the midst of responding to them, is it consistent with who God says you are?
- If yes, in what ways? if no, in what ways?
5. What steps do you take to intentionally grow in God's Word? Why is it important to be diligent?
6. Do you have a few individuals you can ask to hold you accountable? Are you in a season of recognizing who they might be? Perhaps you have that cadre. If so, who are those individuals you can be vulnerable and honest with, who speak God's Truth that you can receive from and trust?
7. What did the Lord reveal to you through today's discussion?
